**Pentecost**

Today is the feast of Pentecost when we remember that remarkable day when God the Holy Spirit fell on the first followers of Jesus as they prayed together in Jerusalem.

This was the promised gift that Jesus had told them that God the Father would give to them to empower them for service and to live within them. All those who trust in Christ receive the Holy Spirit and can experience his love, grace and power in many ways. Let's pray as a Church that we will know his power and see many people coming to a living faith in Jesus.
