# **Welcome to Our Services Today**

This morning we resume our study of 1 Corinthians which we began last October. We pick the letter up at a very opportune - and glorious point with the *single greatest chapter* in the New Testament on the Resurrection of Jesus Christ - and of the resurrection of all who

have put their trust in Him. The sermon title today is critical - "I believe in the Resurrection of the Body". That is the Christian position - not a vague mystical hope - not an absorption into a kind of cosmic soup- no- a bodily, physical reality. Jesus of Nazareth was raised bodily - still bearing the marks of his crucifixion (so they knew it really was him) but a body which had changed. This was a message that all the apostles preached - Jesus and the Resurrection. So Paul in verse 3 of this chapter puts it like this "For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance". It is quite simple - without the resurrection of Jesus there would be no Christian faith and no Christian Church. So as we explore this staggering chapter over the next 3 Sunday mornings let's ask God to help us to see its rich implications for faith in the world we live in.

**This evening** we begin a new series from *Luke* 24 and for three of these Sundays we will be looking particularly at the wonderful encounter that Jesus had with the two disciples on the road from Jerusalem to Emmaus.
