Welcome to Our Services Today

This morning we conclude our series on some of the Parables Jesus told by looking at what have some called "The Parable of the Last Messenger". As we approach the season of Advent and Christmas it's a very powerful parable to consider - it certainly made a very

strong impression on those who first heard it! (Luke 20 v19). The history of the people of Israel – God's chosen people was a history of repeatedly ignoring messengers God sent to them - the Prophets. They wanted to go their own way - as humanity still does - deaf so often to the voice of God - and rejecting the love of God. As we engage with this Parable let's pray that God would make us open in new ways to his love and purposes.

This evening we pick up again on our series "Encounters with the Divine" as we explore the mysterious encounter that Jacob experienced.

Next Sunday evening Ross will be tackling the next of our "Issues Facing Christians Today" series' as we look at the very complex and difficult area of *Christian Responses to Asylum and Immigration*.

On 23rd November, we will be starting a series on the Old Testament book of **Ruth**. It's an amazing story of the power of redeeming love and a wonderful preparation for the season of Advent. In preparation for the series, it would be a really good exercise to read the book through – it's only 4 chapters!
