Welcome to Our Services Today

This morning, we continue our series in the book of Ruth and our theme is "Romance". The book of Ruth contains one of the great love stories of the Bible if not in all literature! Chapter 3 is a wonderful illustration of the way in which God's sovereign plan works through the everyday, faithful actions of ordinary people. It's a chapter of "God behind the scenes"!

We see his providence at work in what look like "coincidental events", steering events towards His purposes of redemption and rescue. God is at work in the lives of Ruth, Naomi and Boaz - even when they don't really know it!

This evening, we are exploring the issue of abortion under the heading of "The Unformed Body - Why Abortion?"

The issue of abortion is one which is always a very controversial one although it remains "under the surface" in British political life - though not of course in the USA. Much attention has been given to debates over end-of-life issues in recent years - but what about before a life is born? What rights does a foetus have in conjunction with the rights of a mother? What role if any should the Church play in the debate?
